## **Build your own little water mill**

The energy of the running water has been used by the human kind since time immemorial. Its power used to turn the millwheels and now it sets in motion the turbines of hydroelectric power plants of all sizes. Making of your own little wooden mill can be entertaining

- 1 straight branch, length 30 cm
- 2 branches with V-shaped ends length according to the height
- 6 8 medical wooden spatulas

# Course of action:

Attach the spatulas to the centre of the branch. Considering its diameter, attach evenly 6 – 8 pieces. Stick the V-shaped branches to the bottom of the stream so that they are approximately 20 cm apart. Then place the mill into the V-shaped branches




